Prof. Jayanta Krishna Sarmah:

In designing a syllabus a standard methodology/ taxonomy should be followed. Instead of "programme objective and out outcome" "Course objective and outcome" should be used.

He also suggested that content of the course should be equally distributed. For example every paper/ course should have maximum four units and every unit should have equal number and maximum of four sub-units respectively.

He recommended suggested readings should be precisely designed by following a standard bibliographic order and it should exceed maximum 15 nos. of list.

Dr. Diganta Hatibaruah:

He also agreed with prof. jayanta krishna sarmah in following a standard taxonomy for formulation of a syllabus.he particularly mentioned the "Bloom Taxonomy" in that regard. He also suggested that in Unit 1. of the political theory paper, the contents of "Power. Authority and Legitimacy" should be removed and "Declining/End and Resurgence of Political theory should be entered.

In the unit 3, "Key concepts in political theory" should be "key concepts in Political Science".

Dr. Minakshi Dutta has suggested that since the first year students are beginner, so we should consider the framing of syllabus in a very easy way. In this regard, she particularly observed that instead of directly start with "theory" the basic concepts relating to political science would be helpful for the students to begin with.
