





On 14th December, in the year 2021, the 5th Semester (Hon.) students have participated in field visit and written good project works on the basis of their field study.

Agnigarh is a hillock located in Tezpur, Assam, India. In Hindu scriptures, it is the site of the fortress which was built by Banasuraa to keep his daughter Usha in isolation. The name itself is derived from the words 'Agni" (meaning fire) and 'garh' (meaning fortress or wall) in Sanskrit. Legendd has it that this fortress was surrounded by fire at all times so that nobody could go in or out of the perimeter without permission. Usha fell in love with Aniruddha in her dreams, not knowing that he was the grandson of Krishna. Her companion Chitralekha identified him by painting his portrait from Usha's description. Chitralekjha Udyan in Tezpur also known as 'Cole Park,' the biggest park in Tezpur, is named after her. Chitralekha was not only an artist but one possessing mystical powers. Anirudddha was Krishna's grandson and Usha, the daughter of an Asura king, therefore was no way any side would consent to their love. She flew one night and brought Aniruddha to Usha's place while he was still sleeping, using her powers. When Aniruddha opened his eyes and saw Usha, he fell in love immediately. However, Banasura was furious on knowing this, and tied him with snakes and imprisoned him. Lord Krishna, however had agreed for their marriage and had wanted for Banasura to consent for the same. Banasura was a great devotee of Lord Shiva, and as a boon had asked him and his entire family to guard the gates of his city, Tezpur. He therefore was not at all scared by Lord Krishna's wrath. A war ensued between the Hari (Lord Krishna and his followers) and the Hars (Lord Shiva and his followers), rivers of blood flowed and the city was named Tezpur (City of Blood). Both sides were nearly wiped out and a final battle followed between Lord Shiva and Lord Krishna, Lord Brahma requested both of them to stop the war by putting him between them. A discussion followed in which Lord Krishna made Lord Shiva see that Banasura was acting wrongly in imprisoning his grandson, and had even disrespected Lord Shiva himself in asking him and his family to be his gate keepers. Lord Shiva agreed, and Banasura was brought. Fearing his life, he immediately agreed to the marriage. The stone sculptures on the Agnigarh hill portray this entire picturesque story of love and great war.

The 'Department of History' on 4th January, 2022 had conducted an educational tour for the 3rd Semester Honours students. It was a two-day trip to Sibsagar of Assam which is around 220 kms from Tezpur. The theme of the tour was 'An Educational Trip to Sibsagar Archaeological Site.' This two-day trip was based on the compulsory Skill enhancement elective course (HIS -SE-3014: Historical Tourism in North East India). There were 53 students. There were 4 teachers of History department accompanied during the tour and they guided the students throughout the trip.

All the students were directed to gather around the College Gate at 7 am. The journey started at 8 am and the destination was reached at 2 pm. The students were taken to visit the Rang Ghar, Kareng Ghar (Gargaon Palace), 15 kms from Sibsagar. Later in the evening the students halted in the Prashanti Tourist Lodge for the night. Next morning the students were taken to visit the following temples- Shiva Dol, Vishnu Dol and Devi Dol on the banks of the Sibsagar Tank (also known as Borpukhuri Tank). The last destination was the Talatal Ghar which was a 18th century palace and military base of the Ahom rulers. The visit to Sibsagar was both an educational and a cultural trip. The above-mentioned monuments are a standing example of outstanding Ahom architecture which is a synthesis of various cultures, traditions, religions. The visit enhanced the knowledge of the students about these historical places and the rich cultural heritage of the state of Assam. Overall, it was a great experience on part of both the teachers and the students. Students were encouraged to learn more through practical experiences. Nevertheless, to say, this trip also instilled leadership quality among them.







#### Write-up about the programme:

The Department of History on 2nd May, 2023 had conducted an educational tour for the 4th semester (Honours) student. It was a day trip to Shillong (Meghalaya) which is around 244 km from Tezpur. The theme of the tour was 'The Sino-Indian War, 1962: Perspectives from Oral History'. This trip was based on the compulsory skill enhancement elective course (HIS-SE-4014: Oral Culture & Oral History). In 1962, Sino-Indian conflict stemmed from a Himalayan border dispute, with China asserting rights over Aksai China area and claimed Tibet. After the 1959 Tibetan uprising, Dalai Lama's asylum in India sparked tension. In 1959, the Dalai Lama's flight to Tezpur triggered Chinese advances towards the city, affecting its plains. Chinese forces reached Bhalukpong route to Tezpur, causing evacuation. During the 1962 war, Tezpur underwent transformation into a ghost town. Among its victim was Winghing Tham, representing the Chinese families in Assam who endured considerable suffering during the conflict. This field trip sheds light on the impact of the war on Tezpur, its populace highlighting the plight of the Chinese community and the resulting familial separations.

This trip investigated the impact of these events in the existing circumstances, their repercussions in Tezpur's populace, and the preparations made for evacuation to gain insights, we conduct two case studies: interview of Winghing Tham (of Chinese origin) and interview of Meenakshi Bhuyan (of Indian origin). The survey was carried out in Dekargaon, where there is still a Chinese family and in Porua Chariali, where Meenakshi Bhuyan lives. The oral investigation relied primarily in primary date and some secondary data. To collect primary data, direct personal interview was made with the respondents. The secondary data was obtained via the internet.

The study was conducted to understand the impact of Indo war (1962). To know, two case studies were taken out. One from family of Chinese origin (Winghing Tham) and other is from family of Indian origin (Meenakshi Bhuyan). Tezpur was the most affected place among the Assam cities and towns. The populace was compelled to evacuate Meenakshi Bhuyan said that the 1962 war changed her small town forever. Tezpur was transformed into ghost town in the time of war. One of the victims of the 1962 was Winghing Tham. It is known where they originally came from the Chinese family in Assam suffered a lot in the war of 1962, got arrested, many Chinese were detained in the Delhi camp and got separated from their family



The team was divided into the groups and they disbursed in different directions to collect data and prepare the survey. The students had mixed experiences while dealing with the rural households. Many of them suspected the surveyors to be some Government agents and they had inhibitions and mental barriers in providing the desired data.
