

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Gauhati University Four Year Undergraduate Programme (GU-FYUGP)

NEP 2020 was implemented in all Higher Education Institutes (HEIs) of Assam from the Academic Session 2023-24 starting from August 2023. This starts the beginning of the Four Year Under-graduate Bachelor Degree Programme (FYUGP) in all colleges and universities under the state jurisdiction from August 2023. Accordingly, Darrang College is offering GU-FYUGP programme from the session- 2023-24.

ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDIT (ABC): As per the New Education Policy- 2020, Government of India has introduced an ABC platform (Academic Bank of Credits). ABC is a national level facility to promote flexibility of curriculum frame work and provide academic mobility of students with appropriate credit transfer mechanism to choose their own learning path to attain a Degree / Diploma / PG Diploma, etc. working on the principle of multiple entry — multiple exit as well at anytime, anywhere and any level of learning. All prospective students who wish to take admission into the GU-FYUGP through Darrang College must be registered with the academic Bank of Credit (ABC) and must obtain the 12-digit ABC ID through Digi Locker platform. Students are encouraged to visit ABC website for all related information which are available along with video tutorial. Aadhar card is mandatory to login in ABC website. (www.abc.gov.in). As per the policy it is compulsory to the students to generate ABC IDs. Students are hereby informed to follow the following steps to get ABC IDs, they can generate ABC IDs through the following links.

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Admission Procedure: For GU-FYUGP

- 1. Admission will be conducted as per NEP–2020 for FYUGP under Gauhati University.
- 2. The candidates have to first register themselves with the Academic Bank of Credit (ABC) by visiting the website https://www.abc.gov.in/ and selecting Gauhati University.
- 3. The next step is to visit https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/ apply for admission in FYUGP under Gauhati University and select Darrang College as one of your preferred College.
- 4. The different programmes are categorized as NEP-STREAM (BA/BSc/BCom) and NEP-DISCIPLINE (BCA/BSc Biotechnology).
- 5. Fee structure and payment mode will be as per government notification.
- 6. Reservation of seats as per government guidelines.
- 7. Admission will be strictly on Merit basis.
- 8. No claim of Admission shall be entertained after the date and time of Admission.
- 9. Admission will be on offline mode basis.
- 10. All original documents have to be produced for verification on the day of Admission.
- 11. Only State and National level certificates will be entertained for the candidates' claiming seats against Co-curricular category.
- 12. A candidate has to submit the following at the time of offline admission.
 - (a) A photocopy of the mark sheet of the last qualifying examination.
 - (b) Caste certificate /certificate for differently able/ Gap certificate (court affidavit only), wherever applicable with size.
 - (c) A recent passport size photograph of the candidate
 - (d) Signature of the candidate (1kb to 30k band 1.5cmX3.5cm)
 - (e) For fee waiver, income certificate issued only from Circle officer will be considered.
- 13. Hostel seats will be allotted strictly on merit basis and as per Govt. Reservation Rules after admission.

Subjects like – Fine Arts, Music, Dance, Work Experience, Vocational subjects will not be considered for counting merit position.

Candidates having more than three years study gap will not be eligible for admission.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS

College Uniform:

College Uniform is compulsory. Students not in proper uniform are not allowed entry to the college. The uniform will be as follows:

For Boys: Black pants (Formal only), sky blue shirt. For Girls: Spun Muga Mekhela and Off white Chadar with maroon border and Maroon Blouse / Off white Saree with Maroon Blouse / Off white Salwar: Off white Dupatta: Maroon Kameez (knee length).

Maroon Sweater and Black shoes/ sandals are common to both boys and girls.

Identity Card: Every Bonafide student will be issued College identity card after admission.

Reservation: The College follows the Government Reservation rules.

Cancellation of seats: Students found absent for a period of 10 days at a stretch after admission without intimation to the authority will forfeit their seats. Besides, a student may have to lose his/her seat in the manner mentioned in "General Rules" stated below:

General Rules:

Students admitted to this college must abide by all rules and regulations of the college. Violation of the rules, irregular attendance, misconduct in any form, adopting unfair means at the examinations and the likes will be treated as serious offences leading to suspension or even expulsion from the college. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Students found indulging in such activities will be expelled from the college. Further, no student is allowed to take-up any other full-time course or hold a service during his / her stay in the college. Organizations, societies etc. of the students of Darrang College, will function only under the guidance of the college authority. Only the organizations /societies recognized by the college authority will be permitted to use the facilities of the College premises. All the notices desired to be pasted or circulated must be countersigned by the Principal.

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COLLEGE LIBRARY

Darrang College has a modern automated library in a separate building in its premises. The library has an impressive collection of books, Journals, Newspapers, Magazines, e-Journals, e-books, bibliographic databases etc.

The newly constructed library with its open access system and spacious reading area provides and atmosphere conductive to the excitement of constructive mentality. Students are encouraged to become sagacious users of the library which is a welcome heaven for intellectual pursuits. Moreover, most of the departments of the college have an individual library called departmental library, which provides additional help to students and teachers in their academic pursuits. The library also provides access to e-resources to the teachers and students through UGC – INFLIBNET N – List programme.

A well-equipped computerized library is an invaluable aid to the young scholars. The college has a state of art library building spreading across three floors. The library remains open from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm on all working days. A student will have to apply on a separate form supplied by the librarian for access to library books. Each student is allowed to borrow three books for TDC (Honours) / PG students and two books for others at a time.

LIBRARY RULES

- Library cards are not transferable.
- Books are issued to students for a period of fifteen (15) days.
- An overdue charge of Rs.5/- only per day is levied if a book is kept beyond the due date.
- Books on loan with members can be recalled at any time without assigning any reason thereof. Borrowers must check the physical condition of the book before getting them issued. Otherwise, they will be held responsible for any damage or mutation notice at the time of return.
- Reference books marked restricted and bound volumes of periodicals and question papers are not issued.
- A fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged for reissue of a library card.
