1. MOU Objective

The primary objective of executing this MOU is to facilitate regular maintenance of the electronic equipment's, repair and reuse of electronic equipment's and spares (as mentioned in Annexure-I) and disposal of E-waste generated in the institution.

2. MOU Period

This MOU is extended with effect from 16/05/2022 for a period of 5 years.

3. Responsibilities of First Party

- 3.1 Giving access to the second party for scheduled maintenance work.
- 3.2 Intimating the second party whenever repairing or upgrading works is needed.
- 3.3 Intimation the second party for collection of e-waste.
- 3.4 Giving necessary access and arranging gate pass for transport of e-waste.

4. Responsibilities of Second Party

- 4.1 Scheduled maintenance work for all electronic equipment's, computers, ups and other accessories.
- 4.2 Repairing and reusing of electronic equipment's and spares. Repairing and maintenance work to be attended within 24 hours of intimation by the first party.
- 4.3 Collection and transport of the e-waste generated from designated site within 15 days from date of intimation at their own cost.

5. E-waste collection & disposal

- 5.1 The E-waste will be collected from the Institute as per the list of items mentioned in the Annexure -1 without any cost.
- 5.2 The Vendor takes the responsibility of safe disposal of the E-waste.
- 5.3 The Vendor under any circumstances will not misuse any confidential matter obtained in any of the electronic storage devices.
