BACKGROUND

The Director of Social Welfare was created by govt. of Assam in the year 1960. The role and responsibility of this department are destined to witness a phenomenal expansion in the coming year due to the heightened social awareness of the problems specially faced by women, children and physically challenged persons. This department was the mandate to ensure proper care of the uncared protection of the most vulnerable section of the society and creation of environment which is conducive to all round development of children, women etc. by the protective hands. In the year, 2022, the Directorate of Social Welfare (Women and Child Development) was renamed as Directorate of Women and Child Development under the control of Department of Women and Child Development and the Directorate of Social Justice and Empowerment under the administrative control of the Department of Social Justice and Empowerment.

The primary responsibilities of the Departments are -

- 1. Women and Child Welfare,
- Care of pre-school children including pre-primary education and their nutrition,
- 3. Implementation of various acts and rules such as the Dowry Prohibition Act, Prohibition of Child Marriage Act etc.
- 4. Welfare of Pragnant and Lactating Women
- 5. Gender equity
- 6. Children in conflict with law and vagrancy and several other issues

- 7. Administration, formulation and implementation of policies and programmes for welfare and development of the Scheduled Caste and Other Backward Classes in the State
- 8. Special schemes aimed at rehabilitation and social, educational and economic empowerment of persons with disabilities, etc.

Darrang College is stablished in 1945 by the people of Tezpur, Darrang College was permanently affiliated to Gauhati University in 1953. The Department of Sociology in the college was established in the year 2011 initially at Higher Secondary level and in the year 2015, B.A. as General course. From the year 2020, Sociology has taught as a Major subject.

The department of Sociology in the college is established with a noble objective of introducing this most essential and timely discipline of this part of Assam and to propagate the knowledge and the use of this branch of Social Science into the society as a whole. As we know, the subject Sociology deals with the study of the society, human beings and human behavior. Firstly, Sociology helps a person in becoming a responsible member of the society who can understand and tackle various problems of the society logically. Apart from it, students of our department have become socially responsible. For example, one of our students celebrated his birthday by feeding the street beggars. Another student distributed sanitary pads free of cost to the needy ones.

The Darangcollege, dept. of Sociology in collaboration with theDepartment of Women & Child Development and Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of Assam, Sonitpur (Tezpur), aims to foster join initiatives in field work, awareness and community development in line with sustainable social practices and welfare enhancement.
