



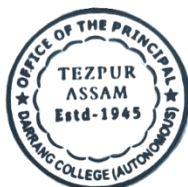

Rules and Regulations, DCSU Election – 2026

For smooth conduct of DCSU Election, 2026 following guidelines are issued and are to be strictly followed. As per decision of the meeting with all students' organisation, police administration and college authorities

- i. Every student must produce latest admission receipt and I-Card at polling centre.
[For 1st semester (UG) and 5th semester (UG), apart from the money receipt, a photo ID must be produced at polling centre (Aadhar Card, Pan Card, Voter ID Card, Driving Licence or Bank Passbook)]
- ii. Banners of candidates can be placed only at specific spot (to be decided by draw of lot on 9th September, 2026 03:00 pm at Principal's meeting room). Maximum two banners and one artefact per candidate will be allowed. Maximum five students per candidate will be allowed to fix banners (06:30 am to 07:30 am) on 10th September, 2026.
- iii. Placing banners of candidates is strictly prohibited within 100 metres on either side of the Main Gate and within 100 metres on either side of Gate No. II (Back Gate) outside of the College premises.
- iv. No musical instrument or music system will be allowed during class campaigning on 7th and 8th September, 2026.
- v. All forms of rallies / postering etc. are strictly prohibited inside college campus.
- vi. Damage to any college property of any kind during the period of election will lead to strict disciplinary action including expulsion from college.
- vii. Campaigning at Girls' Hostel will be allowed on 8th September, 2026 from 03:00 pm (time slot to be decided by draw of lot on 7th September, 2026, 03:00 pm at Principal's meeting room)
- viii. Any student or candidate found violating these Rules and Regulations shall be liable for appropriate disciplinary action as per the rules of Darrang College (Autonomous).
