### Four Year Undergraduate Programme (GU-FYUGP)

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 was implemented in all Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) of Assam from the academic session 2023–24, commencing in August 2023. This marked the introduction of the **Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP)** in all colleges and universities under the jurisdiction of the state. Accordingly, **Darrang College has been offering the FYUGP from the academic session 2025–26 under the academic autonomy conferred by the University Grants Commission, in alignment with the provisions and objectives of the NEP 2020.**

**ACADEMIC BANK OF CREDIT (ABC):** As per the New Education Policy- 2020, Government of India has introduced an ABC platform (Academic Bank of Credits). ABC is a national level facility to promote flexibility of curriculum framework and provide academic mobility of students with appropriate credit transfer mechanism to choose their own learning path to attain a Degree / Diploma / PG Diploma, etc. working on the principle of multiple entry – multiple exist as well as anytime, any – where and any level of learning. All prospective students who wish to take admission into the GU-FYUGP through Darrang College must be registered with the academic Bank of Credit (ABC) and must obtain the 12-digit ABC ID through Digi Locker platform. Students are encouraged to visit ABC website for all related information which is available along with video tutorial. Aadhar card is mandatory to login in ABC website. ([www.abc.gov.in](http://www.abc.gov.in)). As per the policy it is compulsory for the students to generate ABC IDs. Students are hereby informed to follow the following steps to get ABC IDs, they can generate ABC IDs through one of the STEPs given below:

- b) Click on my account ◀ Student.
- c) For New User ◀ Click on “Sign up for Meri Pahchan”
- d) Enter mobile number, you will get OTP on registered mobile Number

- f) Students will get ABC ID. Get these details for college record.

### Admission Procedure: For FYUGP

1. Admission will be conducted as per NEP-2020 for FYUGP of Darrang College under the academic autonomy conferred by the University Grants Commission.
2. The candidates have to first register themselves with the **Academic Bank of Credit (ABC)** by visiting the website <https://www.abc.gov.in/> and selecting Gauhati University
3. The next step is to visit <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in/> and apply for admission in **FYUGP under Darrang College (Autonomous)** as your preferred institution.
4. Fee structure and payment mode will be as per government notification.
5. **Reservation of seats as per government guidelines.**
6. Admission will be strictly on Merit basis.
7. No claim of Admission shall be entertained after the date and time of Admission.
8. Admission will be on offline mode basis. All original documents have to be produced for verification on the day of Admission.
9. Only State and National level certificates will be entertained for the candidates' claiming seats against Co-curricular category.
10. A candidate has to submit the following at the time of offline admission.
  - a. A photocopy of the mark sheet of the last qualifying examination.
  - b. Caste certificate /certificate for differently able/ Gap certificate (court affidavit only), wherever applicable with size.
  - c. A recent passport size photograph of the candidate
  - d. Signature of the candidate (1kb to 30k band 1.5cmX3.5cm)
  - e. For fee waiver, income certificate issued only from Circle officer will be considered.
11. Hostel seats will be allotted strictly on merit basis and as per Govt. Reservation Rules after admission.
12. Subjects like – Fine Arts, Music, Dance, Work Experience, Vocational subjects will not be considered for counting merit position.
13. **Candidates with a study gap of more than three years are generally considered ineligible for admission to undergraduate programmes.**

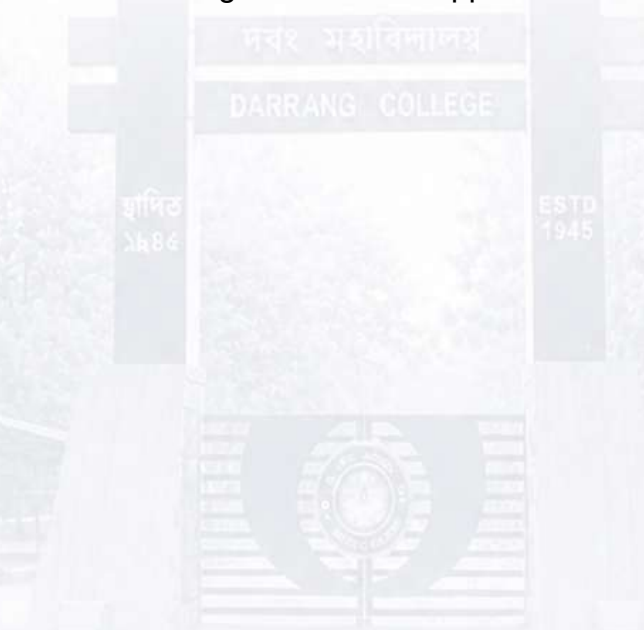

### RULES AND REGULATIONS

**College Uniform:** College Uniform is compulsory. Students who are not in proper uniform are not allowed entry to the college. The uniform will be as follows: For Boys: Black pants (Formal only), sky blue shirt. For Girls: Spun Muga Mekhela and Off white Chadar with maroon border and Maroon Blouse / Off white Saree with Maroon Blouse / Off white Salwar: Off white Dupatta : Maroon Kameez(knee length).

Maroon Sweater and Black shoes/ sandals are common to both boys and girls.

**Identity Card:** Every Bonafide student will be issued College identity card after admission.

**Reservation:** The College follows the Government Reservation rules.

**Cancellation of seats:** Students found absent for a period of 10 days at a stretch after admission without intimation to the authority will forfeit their seats. Besides, a student may have to lose his/her seat in the manner mentioned in “General Rules” stated below:

#### General Rules:

Students admitted to this college must abide by all rules and regulations of the college. Violation of the rules, irregular attendance, misconduct in any form, adopting unfair means at the examinations and the likes will be treated as serious offences leading to suspension or even expulsion from the college. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Students found indulging in such activities will be expelled from the college. Further, no student is allowed to take-up any other full-time course or hold a service during his / her stay in the college. Organizations, societies etc. of the students of Darrang College, will function only under the guidance of the college authority. Only the organizations /societies recognized by the college authority will be permitted to use the facilities of the College premises. All the notices desired to be pasted or circulated must be countersigned by the Principal.

#### Examination Rules:

All examination of the College will be conducted by the College Examination Cell. Due weightage will be given to the prevailing conventions of the college in the conduct of examinations. The student must appear in all the examinations conducted by the college during an academic session, otherwise they will not be allowed to sit in final examination. The examination schedule is embodied in the Academic Calendar of the college. A student expelled from any of the examinations of the Council, or the University will be expelled from the college also. TDC 1st / 2nd Semester students are to take admission in the next promotional classes after appearing in their respective final examinations. A Candidate will get 3 chances in each Part of TDC but in all Parts will get 5 years only. (Ref.: Academic Regulation of Darrang College Autonomous).

### **Attendance Rule:**

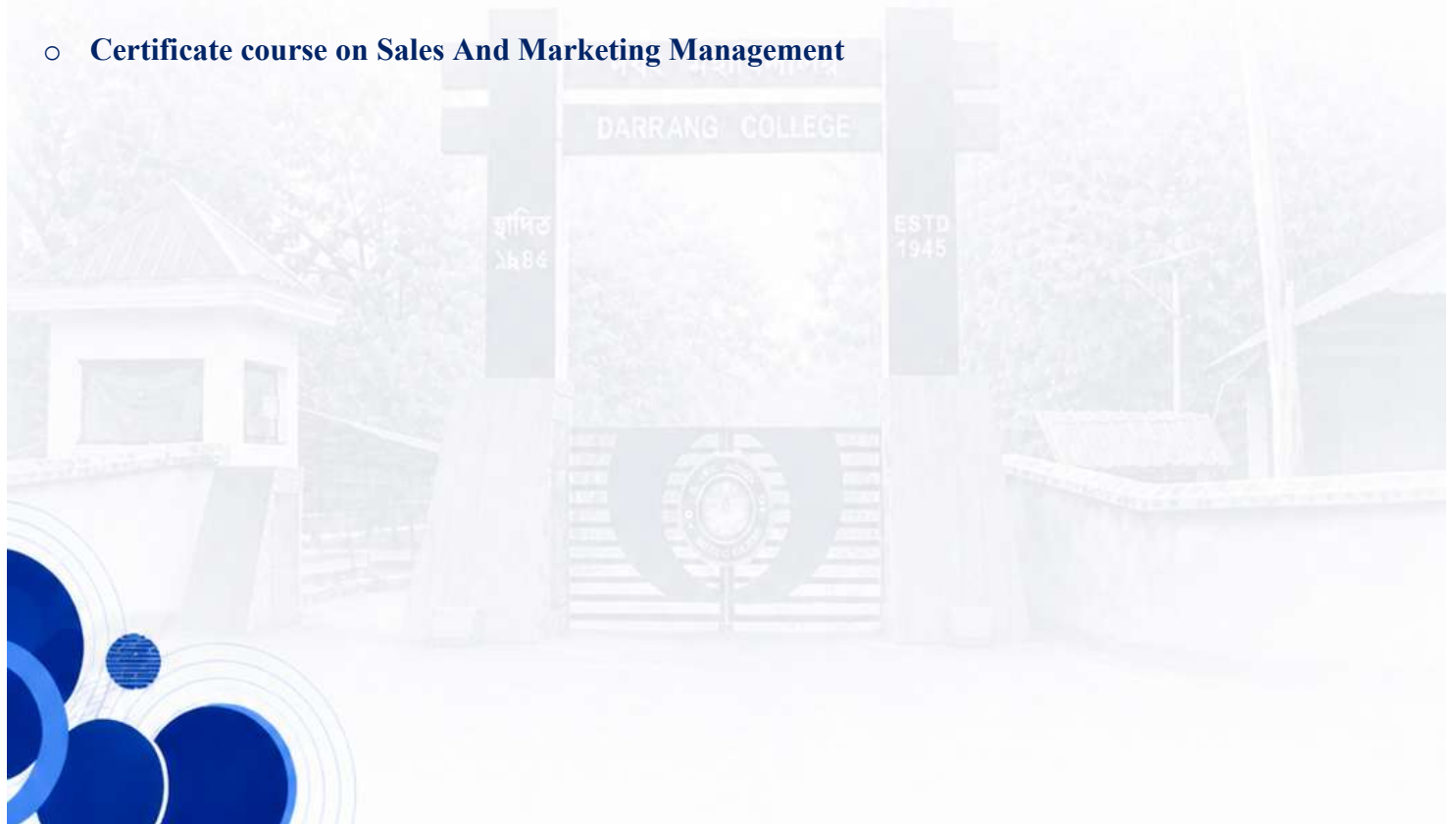

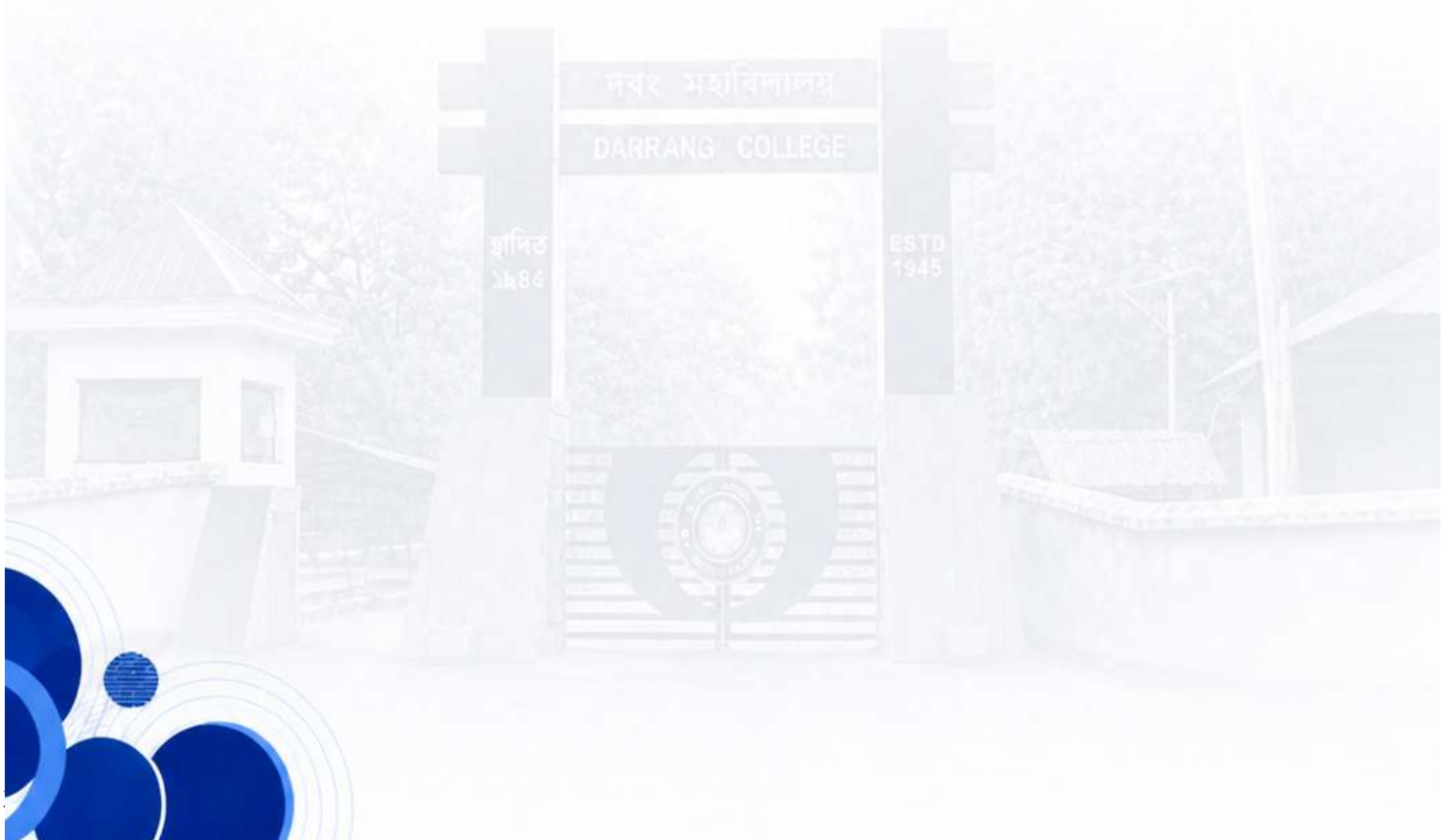
